**Psychiatric Consultation and Internal Medical Staff**

This program has a part time certified Child Psychiatrist on staff to provide med management and psychiatric services. She is on call 24/7. This program is located less than a mile from Brooklawn's residential program and uses its medical services. Those include: four full time nurses, who conduct health screenings, manage all resident health needs, and coordinate efforts in infection control and universal precautions. There is a nurse present or on call at all times.
