Our facility utilizes several community resources in order to provide additional services. Psychiatric services are offered at the Briscoe Clinic, typically by Mazhar Salim, MD. The Briscoe clinic is located at the Baptist Regional Medical Center. Our medication administrator accompanies the residents to all psychiatric appointments in order to discuss their medication regimen with the doctors. Our therapists maintain contact with the psychiatrist on a regular basis in order to collaborate on all residents' progress and occasionally accompany the residents to their psychiatric appointments.
