Describe How the Program Supports Family Connections

Whenever possible, families are involved in treatment planning, regular family therapy and visitation while a resident is participating in the program. Staff members also work with families to develop aftercare plans and to secure community resources prior to reunification. If a resident has a child, staff members work with that resident and DCBS staff to achieve the identified permanency goals for all parties.

Special Interventions Available Internally

Boys and Girls Haven offers therapeutic interventions to meet the individual needs of our residents. These interventions include substance abuse services, equine-assisted therapy, athletic and recreational activities, JSO counseling and trauma-informed care. We also assist residents with enrolling in appropriate education programs. All residents participate in IL skills classes, targeted life skills education, vocational training and job placement services.
