**Psychiatric Services**

Psychiatric services are provided on-site through contracted physician and Psychiatric APRN. Each child receives a psychiatric assessment following admission. On-going psychiatric services are provided to clients that present with issues surrounding mental health needs and/or psychotropic medication management. Typically a child can be seen with-in one week. Urgent psychiatric services are available to address pressing issues, and for client's requiring services during non business hours and weekends. We also have a close working relationship with our local comprehensive care center, and have 24 hour access to mobile crisis team services should a child present as a danger to self/others.
