At Necco, We Build Families! We know the Power of Family and work with each youth to strengthen family bonds and connections. Each youth has a permanency goal as part of their individualized treatment plan. Bio Families are invited to treatment plan meetings and encouraged to be engaged in the treatment planning process. We seek to strengthen family bonds and connections (parents, grandparents, siblings, aunts and uncles, cousins, etc.) whenever possible. We work with state workers, foster parents and family members to provide face-to-face bio family visits (supervised and unsupervised as ordered), telephone contact and home visits (as allowed). The youth's treatment plan includes (as individualized to need and circumstances) goals and objectives related to strengthening bonds with family and other pro-social adults. Family counseling is provided as indicated by each youth's treatment plan to work toward family reunification as appropriate.

Necco Staff link Youth with local physicians and/or onsite Psychiatrist for medication management needs. Youth are typically seen within 30 days of placement and/or when their prescription requires an appointment for monitoring or assessing. Necco Staff monitor and support Youth to ensure consistent medication management and psychiatric services.
