Independent Living – complex owned by Uspiritus houses youth age 18-21. Staff is on-site seven days a week, 365 days per year between the hours of 5 pm – 1 am. Staff can assist with homework, living skills and transportation, 24/7 Therapeutic Case Management (minimum of weekly face-to-face contact), 24 hour crisis intervention, detailed monthly reports provided to the child's state worker, Independent Living Skills, money management, job search & retention, education housing and transportation. Young adults will receive financial assistance including \$100 on the first of each month (\$30 cell phone, \$40 allowance, \$10 personal, \$20 clothing allowance). Young adults will receive a minimum of \$100 gift card for groceries and household expenses twice per month

Uspiritus supports family connections through transportation to family visits (when available), family therapy as appropriate, and inclusion of family of origin in child's treatment team as appropriate.

Special Interventions Available Internally

Uspiritus provides a continuum of quality services to help ensure children experience as few difficult transitions as possible including: Family Preservation, Outpatient BHSO, Therapeutic Foster Care, Independent Living, Residential Private Child Care & Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility. Uspiritus also provides 24/7/365 support to young adults, weekly face to face therapy as well as family and in-apartment/house therapy. Uspiritus as in house clinical staff who provide thorough initial intake assessment, face to face therapy, in home therapy, weekly therapy, and family/group therapy as needed. Uspiritus works in collaboration with contracted psychiatrists and/or nurse practitioners for medication management. Uspiritus has therapists specializing in sexual abuse, substance abuse, and disorders common to abused/neglected children. Uspiritus provides Psycho-educational training and free random drug screens.
